- Materials & Method
- Results
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- References

1. The maximum number of words for abstract content is 350 words (excluding title, names and details of authors).
2. Use only standard abbreviations. Special or unusual abbreviations are not recommended. If otherwise necessary, the latter should be placed in parenthesis after the first mentioned of the full word.
3. All abstracts must be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication.
4. Ensure that all changes, corrections, and proofreading have been carried out before your submission. Once you have submitted, you will not be able to edit the information given.
